



RETRACTABLE BELT BARRIER INSTALLATION GUIDE

Retractable belt barriers, also known as crowd control stanchions, are a popular solution for managing crowd flow and guiding visitors in public spaces such as airports, malls, museums and events such as trade shows. These barriers provide a range of benefits which make them ideal for a variety of different settings.

People to Install:



Equipment / Accessories Needed:


No accessories or tools required.

1



Ensure the area is straight and level before positioning the barrier.

2



Place the barriers along the line that you'd like to mark with the system.

3



Just as you would a tape measure, grab the end of the belt and extend to desired length.

4



Slot the belt into the clip which is fixed to the side of the next stanchion/pole.

5



Secure the clip in place by twisting the lock (beneath the fixing clip). This secures the barrier in place and secures the belt in place.



Useful Tip: The retractable belt barriers do not need to be extended to full extent. You can also use a fixing clip to attach to a wall.



Wear the appropriate PPE for this task.
